**RE: IMPORTANT UPDATES FOR PARENTS.**

We are writing to inform you about several important updates regarding school operations:

**1. TRANSPORT UPDATE:**

We would like to inform you that Bus 7 is supposed to undergo full body repairs and maintenance. As a result, it will not be in operation for a period of time. To ensure uninterrupted transport services for our learners, we have hired an alternative bus to pick up and drop off our learners. Additionally, our school van is undergoing mechanical repairs and is expected to be back in service soon. We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and assure you that in due cause this issue will be resolved promptly.

**2. SCHOOL FEES:**

We kindly remind all parents and guardians that school fees arrears should be settled by **Friday, 20th September 2024**. Learners with fee arrears will not be permitted to attend classes on **Monday, 23rd September 2024**. We urge you to ensure timely payment to avoid disruption to your child's education.

**3. CHANGE OF SCHOOL TIMING:**

We would like to inform you starting **Monday, 23rd September 2024**, school learning activities will end at **4:10 pm** following the last lesson.

This adjustment is in compliance with a directive from the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) circular dated 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, Ref. No. MOE.HQ/3/3/23 which restricts school buses from operating late into the evening beyond 6:00 pm. (Find attached leaf).

We request parents whose children are on private means transport to arrange for their pickup by **4:10 pm** to ensure learners are not delayed in school. Consequently please readjust the timing for picking your child from the school bus drop offs.

**RE: SCHOOL TRANSPORT SAFETY GUIDELINES**

The National Transport Safety Authority NTSA developed the above guidelines for schools' transport. The same were forwarded to all schools via a Circular dated 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, Ref. No. MOE.HQ/3/3/23 signed by the Principal Secretary.

It has come to the attention of the Ministry that the enforcement of the guidelines has not been done across the country and many schools are flouting the regulations.

**The guidelines under number 8.0 procedures for operating buses bans the driving of school buses at night.** These regulations have been contravened where learners are being picked before 6a.m. from their homes. It should be noted that the school buses are expected to be on the road from 6a.m. to 6p.m. and not earlier or later.

The purpose of this communication is to request you to ensure all schools adhere to the Transport Safety Guidelines.
