RE: OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION: INCIDENT AT SCHOOL - 24TH SEPTEMBER 2025

It is with deep regret that I report an unfortunate incident that took place on 24th September 2025, within our school premises. TARIQ SAID, member of the Club physically confronted and assaulted both the Club Treasurer and School Accountant, claiming that his child had been removed from class due to fees arrears. TARIQ was accompanied by ASHUN. Equally FAHMY stormed the school and ordered learners who were waiting for their parents because of fee arrears to go back to class. This is his 4th incident.

For the record, no pupil was denied access to class yesterday.

Parents with fees arrears had only been notified in advance and were yet to be engaged regarding payment plans.

The very shameful incident, which lasted approximately 15 minutes, was immediately reported to Nyali Police Station and investigations are underway.

For and on behalf of the Board of Management of our Club, I do condemn in the strongest terms, the ill-advised criminal acts of Tariq. His acts are uncivilized and uncouth to say the very least and have no place in our Club and/or an institution of learning like our school.

The Board of Management of the Club will convene a special meeting to deliberate on the matter and take measures to safeguard our members, staff and the learning environment from similar incidents in the future.
